

The General Director's Speech:

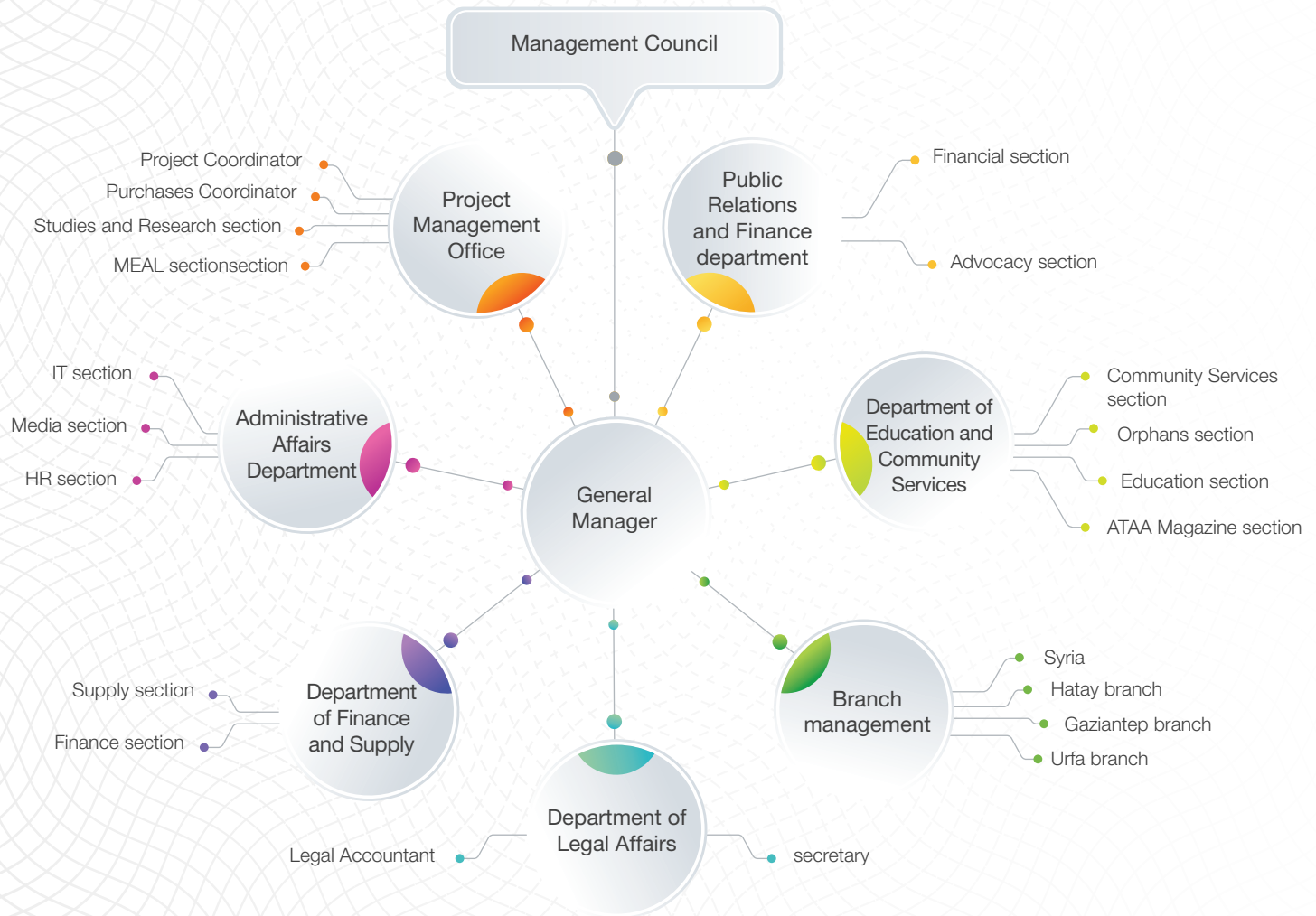

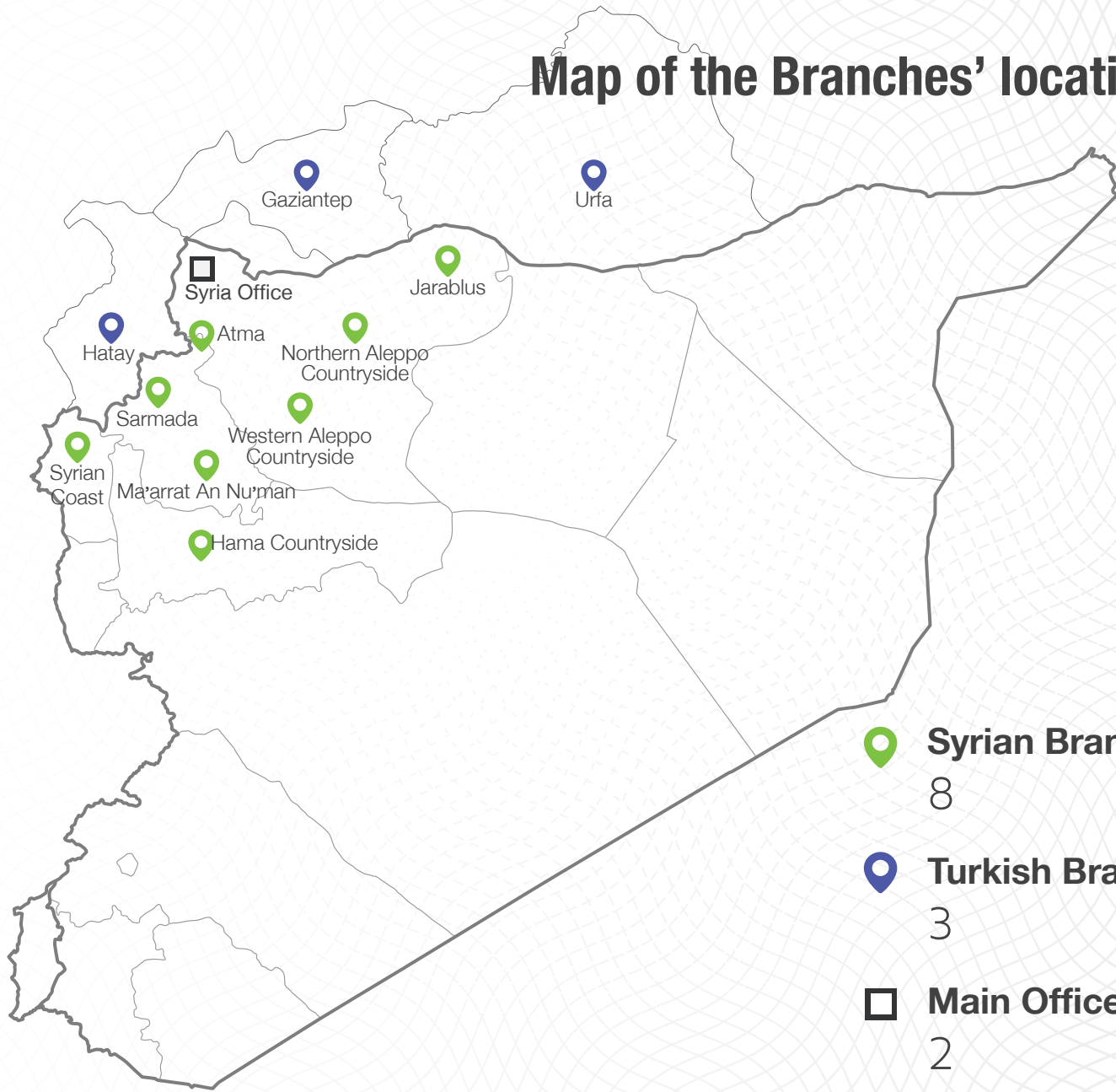

Administrative Structure



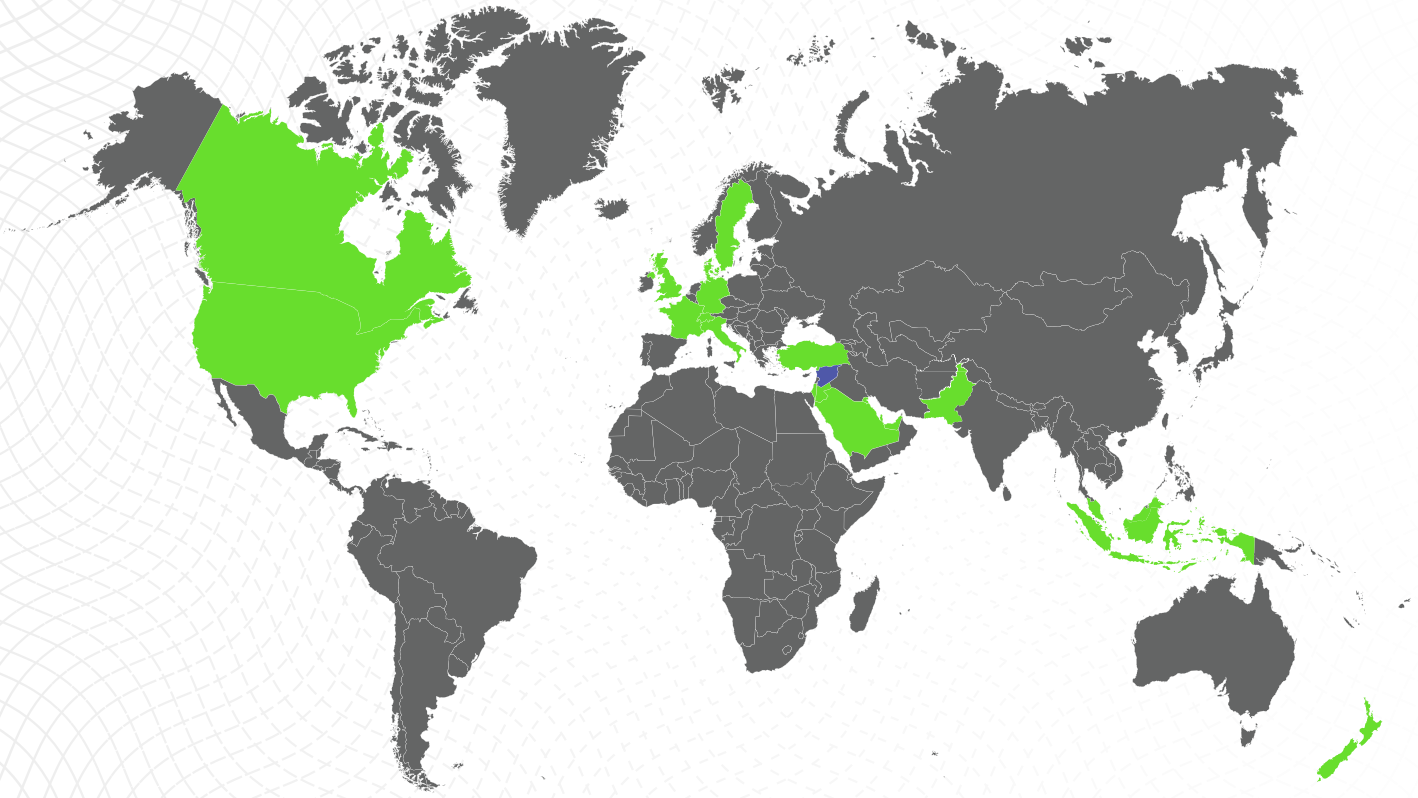

In the framework of our strong relationship with the international associations and under the support of the Indonesian ACT organization, the first humanitarian ship provided by the Indonesian people to their Syrian brothers in need was sent on the 21st April 2018 from the Indonesian Belawan port.

And after a month, the ship landed at Assan port in Hatay-Turkey. Then the ship was received and sent in the presence of Turkish and Indonesian officials.

The rice was distributed in the border area between Syria and Turkey and inside Syria to 3500 families.

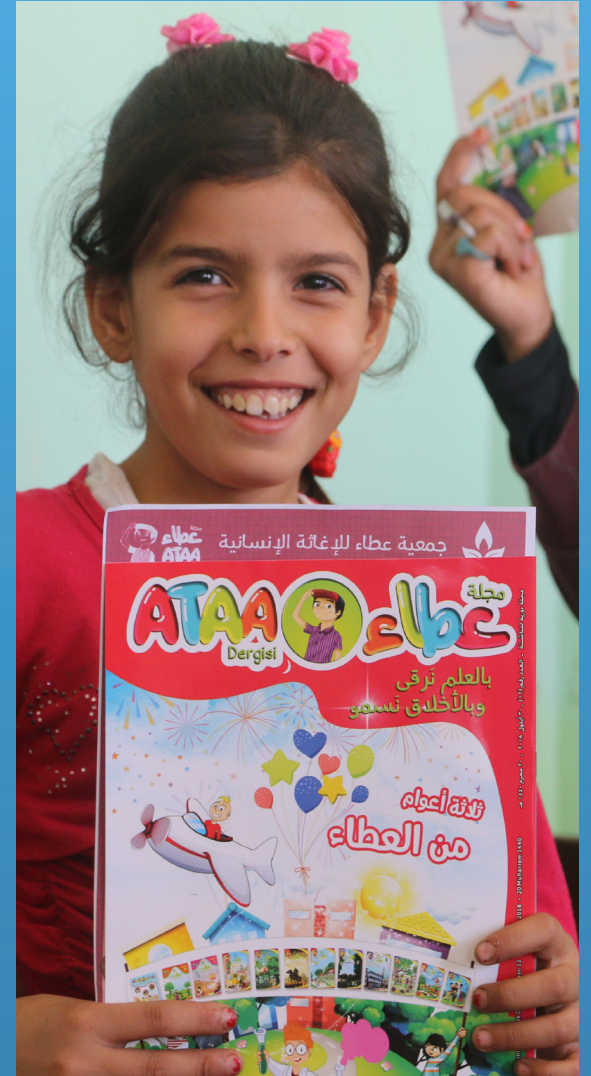

The center is a concrete building including 13 vocational training workshops of the most needed professions in the local labor market. The training capacity reaches more than 700 trainees per year, and it is the only center the northern part of Syria.

A project of Ataa PHC in Hatay-Turkey, it consists of seven main clinics for women, children, internal diseases and dental diseases (4 clinics) in addition to a pharmacy, medical laboratory and specialized clinics such as ophthalmological, dermatological, urological, ENT clinics and other small surgeries

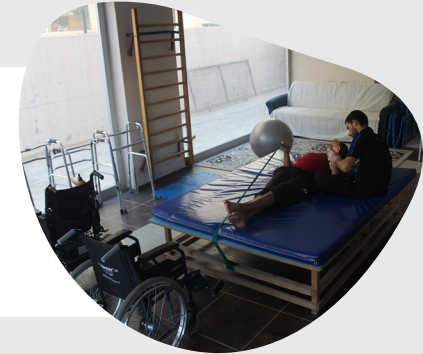
